

## LOS ALAMOS and surrounding area



History buffs and science geeks will want to make a trip "up the hill" to Los Alamos. As one might expect, most of the laboratory is off limits to sightseers, but the **Bradbury Science Museum in Los Alamos** is worth the trip.



If you fancy yourself an amateur archaeologist, make the 40-minute drive from Santa Fe to **Bandelier National Monument**, where you'll find the remains of an ancient Pueblo people called the Anasazi.



An easy two-mile hike provides access to ruins and petroglyphs along the canyon walls.
